## *Annual Meeting*

Every October we have an annual association meeting. At that meeting we review and vote on the annual budget, board members and discuss other association items. It is a great way to meet your neighbors. Please come! Watch for the exact date to be set in late summer.

## *Pool Usage*

In order to receive a key fob for the pool you will need to fill out a Pool Membership Packet on the website: [www.yourjlca.com](http://www.yourjlca.com). Please allow at least two-weeks for processing.

## *Architectural Change Request ("ACR")*

If you wish to make changes to the exterior appearance of your property please visit the website and complete an ACR for approval prior to implementing any changes.

## *Board Positions*

If you are interested in becoming a JLCA Board member please watch for the packet in the fall to nominate yourself. Voting occurs at the Annual Meeting. We are always interested in having more volunteers "on board"!

## *Your Contact Info*

We want to keep you in the loop! Our main form of communication is sent via email or posted on the website. Please be sure to visit the website and complete a "Resident Update Form" so we have your email address.

## *Trash Cans*

One of the most commonly ignored neighborhood covenants is the storage of trash bins. It is against association covenants to store trash bins on the outside of your dwelling where it is visible to by other homeowners. Please be compliant in this as it helps keep our neighborhood looking nice which means maintaining our property values.

## *Area Garage Sales*

Every spring and fall we have garage sales scheduled to coincide with many of the adjacent neighborhoods. The board communicates the dates as soon as they know them. It takes some work to coordinate over five neighborhoods so please be patient with us as we work it out. The garage sales usually occur in late April or Early May and late September but that is not always the case.

## *Annual Dues*

Annual Dues are due each year by January 31<sup>st</sup>. You will receive an invoice in the mail.

Dues pay for things such as snow removal, mowing and landscaping of common areas, pond maintenance, the pool, electricity for the street lights, and general upkeep as required.

The annual budget is sent out each Fall prior to the Annual meeting where it is reviewed and voted on for approval.
